



## Welcome to He Reigns Rescue Ranch!

To better prepare your child for ranch sessions, please review the following items:

**#1 You or the child's guardian must stay at the ranch during the entire ranch session.** Please feel free to make yourself comfortable in the shady bench area by the tack room, and help yourself to some lemonade!

**#2 Please have all forms completed prior to coming to the ranch.** Due to insurance requirements and the unpredictable nature of horses and ranch life, a completed *Rider Information Sheet*, which includes authorization/ consent for emergency medical treatment, and a completed *Liability Release* must be on file for each child. Parents /guardians and any siblings or guests who come to the ranch must also have a completed *Liability Release*. Anyone without current paperwork on file will not be allowed to participate in activities at the ranch.

### **#3 What to Wear:**

- Children should apply sunscreen prior to the ranch and bring extra with them.
- Children must have long pants to ride. Shorts may be worn on very hot days, but your child will need to use the tack room to change into long pants before riding.
- Children must wear sturdy, closed toe shoes. No flip flops/sandals allowed at the ranch!
- No "spaghetti strap" shirts allowed at the ranch.
- Children should bring a hat for sun protection. A riding helmet will be provided.

**#4 Please notify the ranch as soon as possible if your child cannot attend their scheduled ranch session** so another child on the waiting list might have the opportunity to come during that time slot. Three days notice would be greatly appreciated, however, we do understand schedules change and unexpected events occur at the last minute. If this is the case, please notify us as soon as possible.

**#5 Remember ... ranch sessions are your child's special day.** Please be considerate of that by allowing the ranch leaders to focus their attention and guidance solely on the children involved in the ranch session. Parents/ guardians are responsible for friends / siblings brought to the ranch.
